Fire-rescue Engine 3 of the Winslow Fire Department is a Pierce "Saber" custom built for the City of Winslow, Arizona. E3 and her older sister E1 are the only fire rescue engines serving a 900 square mile area of northeastern Arizona. They serve a city of 9,000 citizens, the I-40 corridor of northern Arizona and countless rural homes and native Americans. In 2000, the department responded to 203 fire alarms and 1260 Emergency Medical Alarms. E3 entered service at the Winslow Fire Department in 2000. E3 is the newest engine to the WFD and is capable of pumping 1500 gallons per minute of water. E3 is also the main EMS unit. Engine 3 was custom built for the WFD by PIERCE in 2000.
